ALUMNI SUPPORT CONTINUES TO GROW FOR CONSTRUCTION OF NEW HOUSE

The ATO Capital Construction Fund Drive, now in its eighteenth month, continues to receive growing support from Zeta Lambda Alumni. During the next six weeks, the Board of Directors will intensify contacts with Zeta Lambda Alumni to enlist their support for the construction project. Groundbreaking is now scheduled for Founder's Day on May 9th in Murray.
