## ***Construction Completed!***

### **FRATERNITY BEGINS NEW ERA AT 1511 WEST MAIN STREET**



Construction was completed on August 15th on the new Chapter House at 1511 West Main Street in Murray. The active Chapter occupied the new 25-man house for the first time on August 21, 1993.

Construction Subcommittee Chairman, David Graham, and his Committee are continuing their work on the Carriage House (Chapter Room) and anticipate completion by September 15, 1993. Paving, landscaping and other miscellaneous touch-up work

should be completed by the end of September. The ATO "showplace" will be put on display for its alumni and the community during Homecoming on October 8-9. The new house will be formally dedicated at a special ceremony on the front porch of the House at noon on Saturday, October 9, 1993, during Homecoming. ## CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION FUND DRIVE CONTINUES...

Although construction of the new Chapter House is now complete, the fund-raising continues. As a result of cost overruns and in order to furnish the house in its entirety for use by the Chapter in the fall semester, the Alumni Association obtained a short term loan of \$65,000 to cover these costs. The loan was in addition to the original monies borrowed by the Alumni Association to construct the new House. The Board of Directors has set a goal of December 1993 to pay this short term debt in full.

The Capital Construction Fund Drive to date has received in excess of \$160,000 in pledges and contributions. The President of the Alumni Association, Jeff S. Taylor, notes that many alumni have made pledges during phone-a-thons over the past two years, but have not made their contributions to date. The Alumni Association requests that all pledges be paid as soon as possible. Those alumni who donate \$1,000 or more will become Lifetime Members in the Association and will receive permanent recognition of this accomplishment in the new Chapter House. Brothers who contribute less than \$1,000 will receive recognition in a special dedication program that will be distributed at

Homecoming. Any alumnus who has not begun payment on his pledge by September 15, 1993 will not be included in the program. To date, approximately 250 Brothers have contributed to the project. This represents only 25% of Zeta Lambda's alumni. The Board of Directors intends to continue fund-raising for the next 12 months to not only pay the short term note, but to reduce the construction loan.

## HOMECOMING '93

Homecoming at Murray State University will be held October 8-9, 1993 in Murray. The Zeta Lambda Chapter of Alpha Tau Omega has been designated as the feature campus organization by MSU during the weekend's festivities. The spotlight will be on ATO in Murray on October 8-9 as the Alumni and Housing Association dedicate the new Chapter House. Homecoming festivities will include a four man golf scramble, cocktail reception, brunch/annual meeting, dedication ceremony, campus/community open house and a reception and dance. A summary of the weekend's activities is set forth below. The Alumni and Housing Association President, Jeff S. Taylor, estimates that 250-300 alumni will attend this year's Homecoming activities since this will be the first Homecoming at the Chapter House which will be formally dedicated at Homecoming. This will be the single largest gathering of ATO alumni from Zeta Lambda Chapter in the history of the Chapter.

The assessment for the weekend's activities is \$50 per alumnus or \$65 per couple (Lifetime Members of the Association attend free of charge). The assessment does not include the golf tournament. Green fees, cart and entry fee will be payable at the Murray Country Club.

Make plans now to attend the celebration and dedication for the new Chapter House on October 8-9 in Murray.
